



Thai Touch Wedding Package

Buddhist Ceremony THB 69,000++

- Use of Chapel with air-conditioning, altar and seating for up to 50 guests
- 3 Monks to do blessing, Thai set up, with water blessing equipment and gift and donation to Monks
- Personalized welcome board
- Private ferry for bride and groom from hotel to Chapel
- Photographer during ceremony at Chapel (100 digital photos on CD)
- Bottle of sparkling wine for toasting in the Chapel garden
- Fresh floral bouquet for bride and corsage for groom, garlands for couple

Element

1. Buddhist Praying Ceremony

3 Buddhist monks will pray over the couple, who will then present an offering to the monk. Thai people believe that this offering will assure long lasting love and unity between the couple.

2. Symbolic Ceremony

Symbolic Garland - The garlands will be placed around the necks of the bridal couple, with the belief that the couple will stay together forever.

Spots of Powder - Three spots of white holy powder will be applied on the foreheads of the bridal couple. It is believed that once applied, the bride and groom cannot change their minds or choose a different partner.

Buddhist Sling - The Buddhist sling, representing unity, will be placed on the heads of the bridal couple, signifying that they will not be separated and will have a long life together.

3. Water Blessing Ceremony

Sometimes married couples get angry or jealous and may have bad feelings towards each other. Thai people believe that pouring water over the bride and groom's hands will ensure their hearts stay cool and calming hot-tempered feelings. Guests can also express their best wishes by pouring holy water over the hands of the couple.

This symbolic Ceremony takes about 30-45 minutes, depending on how many guests there are for the water blessing, couple will have use of the Chapel and Chapel gardens for 1.5 hours. There are 3 time slots 10am, (must leave Chapel area by 11:30), 1pm (must leave Chapel by 2:30pm) and 4pm, (must leave chapel by 5:30pm). Usually for a Buddhist wedding, it is traditional to do it in the 10am or 1pm time slots.
